Posters will be displayed in the entrance to the clubhouse reminding members to use hand sanitizer, not to touch face, eyes etc. Guidelines will be emailed to members and put on Facebook and the club website Members will be reminded to wash hands before coming to the club and wash them again as soon as they return home. Additionally, a hand sanitizer will be provided for use before and after
