Toilet and Kitchen area  Handwashing  Handwashing facilities are provided — although no running hot water is available in the toilet areas. Disposable handtowels are provided.  Toilets are only cleaned once a week by our cleaner. Members are asked to clean the toilet seat and flush using the wipes provided before and after using the toilet.	Members will access the club via the junior room. As little time as possible should be spent in the junior room.  Guidelines will be issued to members.  Posters will be displayed in the entrance to the clubhouse reminding members to use hand sanitizer, not to touch face, eyes etc. Guidelines will be emailed to members and put on Facebook and the club website  Members will be reminded to wash hands before coming to the club and wash them again as soon as they return home. Additionally, a hand sanitizer will be provided for use before and after play. Also reminded to catch coughs and sneezes in tissues. Follow catch it, bin it.
